Rules:

- 1) Dress code is the same as the Nationals, that is **all males and females will be required to wear full length pants only and shirts with a collar during all competition. No skirts, skorts, walking shorts, culottes, scooters, spandex, fleece or torn items. All clothing must be loose fitting. Jeans, shorts scooters, warm-up suites or clothes with drawstrings at the waist or elastic at the ankles are not allowed. No writing on or defacing of the bowling shirt will be permitted at any time. Hats cannot be worn during competition.**
- 2) The tournament will have two divisions, a Male and Female Division. Tournament Director may add more divisions depending upon the number of entries. The additional divisions will be based upon age level.
- 3) Award Funds will be used as Scholarship Money and other awards for bowlers.
- 4) Entry Fee is \$40. There is a \$10 processing fee for walk-ins the day of the tournament. Expenses-Lineage \$16.00, Expenses \$4.00, Awards \$20.00.
- 5) Scholarships will be given for: High Game Scratch-Both Genders (\$25) and High Consecutive Three Games- Both Genders (\$25) with a minimum of 5 competitors in each division. All award feels collected will be returned 100%. Additional scholarships may be awarded at a ratio of 1 in 10 or major fraction thereof.
- 6) There will be !!!!!NO BRACKETS!!!!
- 7) This tournament is certified USBC and shall be governed by USBC rules. Open to all USBC youth bowlers plus nonmembers that pay a \$2 tournament participation fee or pay a \$14 USBC associate membership fee.
- 8) Competitors shall be allowed ten minutes of practice on their starting lane before each block of competition.
- 9) Walk-ins will be accepted up to 30 MINUTES before first squad starting time. If you plan on walking in please arrive early. Entry is limited to the first 108 signups between the non Junior Gold and Junior Gold divisions.
- 10) Ties for qualifying sports will be broken by a one game roll off on a pair randomly drawn by the tournament director.
- 11) Competitors are not allowed to use tobacco products during. Competitors are not allowed to abuse equipment, or use any profanity. The first offense will receive a warning; the second offense will be IMMEDIATE disqualification.
- 12) Any items not covered by the rules will be determined by the USBC rule book and enforced by the tournament director or one of the assistant tournament directors.
- 13) There will be an overall series winner for each gender. Points will be awarded for each tournament as follows: 1st place-25, 2nd-22, 3rd-19, 4th-17, 5th-15, 6th-13, 7th-12, 8th-11, 9th-10, and decreasing one point for each spot down to 1. Everyone will receive at least one point for bowling. The amount of scholarship will be determined at the end of the 6 tournaments.
- 14) Competition will consist of 8 games moving pairs every game. If you are on the odd numbered lane, you will move left after each game, if you are on an even numbered lane you will move right. Competitors will be mixed with the corresponding Jr. Gold tournament.

Rules:

- 1) Dress code is the same as the Nationals, that is **all males and females will be required to wear full length pants only and shirts with a collar during all competition. No skirts, skorts, walking shorts, culottes, scooters, spandex, fleece or torn items. All clothing must be loose fitting. Jeans, shorts scooters, warm-up suites or clothes with drawstrings at the waist or elastic at the ankles are not allowed. No writing on or defacing of the bowling shirt will be permitted at any time. Hats cannot be worn during competition.**
- 2) The tournament will have two divisions, a Male and Female Division.
- 3) If you do not hold a Jr. Gold Card you must purchase one before competition begins. Applications will be available at the sign in desk.
- 4) Qualifiers will be 1 in 5 and major fractions thereof. (Example, 12 bowlers, 2 advance, 13 bowlers, 3 advances). Number of qualifiers will be announced before the beginning of competition. Balance of funds will be used as Scholarship Money.
- 5) Entry Fee is \$80. There is a \$10 walk-in late processing fee when paying day of the tournament. Expenses-Lineage \$16.00, Expenses \$6.00, Awards (Jr. Gold entries, Trophies, Scholarships) \$58.00.
- 6) Scholarships will be given for: High Game Scratch-Both Genders (\$25) and High Consecutive Three Games- Both Genders (\$25), First Place Both Genders (\$100). All award fees collected will be returned 100%. Additional scholarships may be awarded at a ratio of 1 in 10 or major fraction thereof. (All scholarships based upon a minimum of 6 entries in each gender division).
- 7) This tournament is certified by the USBC and shall be governed by USBC rules.
- 8) Competitors shall be allowed ten minutes of practice on their starting lane before each block of competition.
- 9) Walk-ins will be accepted up to 30 MINUTES before first squad starting time. If you plan on walking in please arrive early. There is a \$10 admin fee for Walk-ins as reflected in rule 5. Entry is limited to the first 108 signups between the non Junior Gold and Junior Gold divisions.
- 9) Ties for qualifying sports will be broken by a one game roll off on a pair randomly drawn by the tournament director.
- 10) Competitors are not allowed to use tobacco products during. Competitors are not allowed to abuse equipment, or use any profanity. The first offense will receive a warning; the second offense will be IMMEDIATE disqualification.
- 11) Any items not covered by the rules will be determined by the USBC rule book and enforced by the tournament director or one of the assistant tournament directors.
- 12) There will be an overall series winner for each gender. Points will be awarded for each tournament as follows: 1st place-25, 2nd-22, 3rd-19, 4th-17, 5th-15, 6th-13, 7th-12, 8th-11, 9th-10, and decreasing one point for each spot down to a minimum of 1 point. The amount of money for the Premier spot will be determined at the end of the 6 tournaments but will be a minimum of \$500.
- 13) Competition will consist of 8 games moving pairs every game. If you are on the odd numbered lane, you will move left after each game, if you are on an even numbered lane you will move right.
