2011 KENTUCKY STATE USBC 7TH ANNUAL ADULT / YOUTH BOWLING SCHOLARSHIP TOURNAMENT

Rules and Format

Please Read Carefully

1. This Tournament is Kentucky USBC certified by the USBC Youth, Men and Women and shall be governed by the Rules of USBC Youth, Men and Women. Rule 400 will apply to both Youth and Adult. Rule 301b enforced.
2. This will be a unisex Tournament, Male & Female, Male & Male or Female & Female.
3. This Tournament is opened to any Adult Bowler who is USBC certified in 2011-2012. If an adult bowler is not certified thru the USBC, he/she may purchase a \$5.00 participation membership.
4. This Tournament is open to any USBC 2011-2012 certified Youth bowler.
5. This Tournament will use highest 2010-2011 season ending average for 12 games or more for both the Adult and Youth bowler. All averages used must be "USBC" league averages (Rule 319a). Anyone without a 2011-2012 season ending average for 12 games or more at the time of bowling may use their highest current season certified USBC league average based on 12 or more games at the time of bowling State Adult/Youth Tournament. Averages must be verified by a standing sheet at the time of bowling. Failure to provide a verified average will result in the bowler using a 220 average. Bowlers using an incorrect average will result in their score being disqualified and any winnings being forfeited.
6. Reporting of previous tournament winnings will not apply (Rule 319d). The average adjustment rule will not apply (Rule 319a, item 2 and 319e).
7. Handicap will be based on 90% of a 220 average.
8. There will be three (3) divisions, Doubles 375 and over 325 thru 374 and 324 and under.
9. All bowlers will bowl 3 games in the Doubles EVENT. Cost for this tournament is \$12.50 per person, (bowling fee-\$4.35 and scholarship fee-\$8.15). Walk-in entries will be accepted after April 14, 2012 to April 29, 2012 as to lane availability. Returned check fee will be \$30.00.
10. Make Checks or Money Order Payable To: Kentucky State USBC Youth Association.
11. This Tournament will consist of 2 member DOUBLES Event, (1 adult and 1 youth bowler).
12. Bowlers may bowl additional times in Doubles Event provided (1) member of the double is changed.
13. All bowlers must wear suitable attire. No clothing with offensive writing (language, alcohol or tobacco products).
14. NO ALCOHOLIC beverages will be served to Adult bowlers while bowling in this tournament. No smoking while in this tournament.
15. Bowlers will be allowed 5 minutes of practice on starting lanes before their squad starts.
16. A bowler arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning with the frame then being bowled. Frames missed shall be credited with a zero. A bowler not present and ready to bowl when it is his/her turn will be credited with a zero for that frame.
17. Only bowlers and Tournament Officials shall be permitted in settee area during competition.
18. Claims of errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the Tournament Director no later than thirty minutes after completion of the Tournament. Questionable errors shall be decided upon by the Tournament Director. All other protests must be confirmed in writing to the Tournament Director within 48 hours or before the awards are given out. Each protest under this rule must be specific in itself.
19. Scholarships will be given in both Divisions to YOUTH BOWLERS ONLY. Additional Scholarships may be awarded based on the number of entries received.
20. Awards will be returned 100% to bowlers based on a 1 for 10 entries. In case of a tie, scholarship will be split.
21. All matters not covered by these rules and regulations shall be determined by the Kentucky State USBC Tournament Committee.
22. Scholarships will be administered by Kentucky State USBC and Smart Program. All scholarship money will be deposited in the USBC Smart Program, account #10519.
