Scratch Awards (Rule 14)

All awards returned 100% in trophies or plaques.
No refunds after squad times have been scheduled.

A \$30.00 service fee will be added to any returned check. If for any reason the check can not be processed through the account the check will be turned over to the County Attorney's office for collection.

KENTUCKY STATE USBC YOUTH DRESS CODE - ENFORCED

Pants, shorts, skirts, or dresses with hem not exceeding five (5) inches above the knees. Shirts with sleeves, blouses or sweaters may be worn provided there are no noticeable holes. Names, numbers, illustrations and bowling emblems may be worn. ALL UNDERCLOTHING MUST BE WORN. Fringes, fishnets, mid-riffs, halters, tank tops or head attire MAY NOT BE WORN. OBSCENE FIGURES OR DEROGATORY WRITING ON CLOTHING OR PATCHES ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE.

ANYTHING NOT MENTIONED ABOVE WILL BE LEFT TO THE DISCRETION OF THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR. THIS CODE WILL BE ENFORCED AND ANY BREAK OF THESE STANDARDS WILL RESULT IN REMOVAL OF BOWLING PRIVILEGES.

RULES OF THE STATE TOURNAMENT

1. All USBC rules shall be observed.
2. Entries are open to all Kentucky State USBC members.
3. (A) Bowlers will use their highest average of current year, minimum 12 games, as of February 18th. Others will use average at time of tournament minimum of 12 games, with verification of average by coach or Association Secretary.
(B) Bowlers who do not have an official average will bowl scratch.
(C) Each bowler may enter doubles and singles event one time as a regular bowler. You may substitute in doubles event under circumstances deemed necessary by the on-site Tournament Official. First doubles event rolled will count for all events. For team event see Rule 5.
4. If bowling in doubles, you must also bowl in singles or vice-versa.
5. Multiple participation team only. You may enter 3 times in team event but no more than 2 players on one team can place more than once on the awards list for position standings. First team event rolled will count for all events.
6. Handicap will be 90% of difference between average and 233.

8. If there are less than four (4) entries in any classification, they will be placed in the next lower division.
9. After a score has been passed by the official scorer and team captain or individual contested, it can not be changed, except when there is an obvious error in calculation or scoring. Score sheets must NOT be copies. All corrections must be made on the original score sheet.
10. All bowlers must be present 30 minutes before schedule time.
11. Falsification of any entry will result in automatic disqualification of bowler or bowlers.
12. Any damage to bowling establishment or equipment caused by bowler or bowlers during the tournament, said bowler or bowlers will be held liable. Bowler or bowlers will be disqualified from further bowling.
13. Entries will be processed by the date received with consideration given to distance traveled.
14. Trophies will be awarded on at least 1-10 ratio in team, doubles, singles and all events in each division. Scratch awards will be awarded to the boy and girl who has high game, high series, high all events scratch in each division.
15. Scholarships will be awarded for first placed winners in all events handicap in each division (boy and girl). All scholarships will be administered by the SMART Program.
16. No smoking and/or use of any tobacco products. No game machines played will bowling in progress.
17. Should any bowler merit an award emblem, the coach is responsible for filing application for said award.
18. Any protested game or problems that may occur during the tournament can be referred to the State Board of Directors for final decision should the on-site Tournament Director choose to ask.
19. Entry fee—lineage \$4.35, awards \$3.00 and expenses \$2.65. All events money returned 100% in scholarships.
20. NO REFUNDS AFTER SQUAD TIMES HAVE BEEN SCHEDULED.
21. The tournament committee reserves the right to refuse any and/or all entries.
22. In consideration of conducting the tournament, release the KY state USBC Youth, their officers, members, employees and agents from any or all liability involving entrant as a result of entrant's participation therein.
23. **Rule 301b. A Youth Tournament is one in which youth members participate where no cash or bonds are offered or merchandise prizes exceed \$500.00 in value. Youth participants will not wear apparel or use bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, an illegal substance or inappropriate language/gestures during completion.**
24. **Any Rule not covered will reflect to the USBC Rule book.**
